



Abandoned Uranium Mine Technical Services and Cleanup Industry Day

In January 2015, the United States (U.S.) and the Anadarko Litigation Trust (“Litigation Trust”) entered into a settlement agreement with Anadarko Petroleum Corporation and some of its affiliates. The settlement was approved by the U.S. District Court and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) received (~\$985,000,000) for the cleanup of the Tronox Navajo Area Abandoned Uranium Mines (Tronox NAUM) sites. Through informal and formal consultation, the USEPA and Navajo Nation EPA will continue their ongoing process of prioritizing response actions for the Tronox NAUM sites. Projects associated with this settlement will be primarily at uranium mining-related sites that may have an impact on or within the Navajo Nation (within EPA Region 9 in Arizona and New Mexico) and within the Grants Mining District (located in EPA Region 6 New Mexico).

In an effort to engage tribal owned businesses and other local small businesses on the upcoming projects associated with this massive effort, EPA is teaming with SBA to give businesses a chance to learn more about future opportunities related to this cleanup.
